



Tribal Lands tour

Togo & Benin

Lomé – Potossomé – Ouidah – Ganvié – Abomey – Tamberma Valley – Kpalimé – Togoville

Day 1: Lomé

Arrive in Lomé, be met at the airport and transfer to your hotel for the night.

Day 2: Lomé – Potossomé

Early in the morning, leave Lomé and drive to Potossomé in Benin via Hilacondji. On arrival, start your tour with a hiking expedition through Possotomé voodoo village. There will be a possibility to meet a priest. (optional). Spend the night in Possotomé.

Hotel Village Ahémé

Day 3: Potossomé – Ouidah

Drive to Ouidah and spend the day visiting the Temple of pythons, one of the most notable sights of Ouidah. The temple hosts about 50 different pythons that are fed and taken care of by designated locals. These snakes are an important part of Voodoo worship in the area. Visit also the Museum of History, follow the slavery route and go through the Door of No Return and understand an important part of the country history.

Day 4: Ouidah – Ganvié – Abomey

Berakha Tours & Travel, your gateway to West Africa.

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In the morning, drive to Calavi. On arrival, take a boat to go to Ganvié stilt village on lake Nokoué. The Venice of Africa, the largest stilt village of the region of Calavi, where 12,000 fishermen live. They were created over three hundred years ago when the local tribes moved into the shallow Lake Nakoué to avoid capture and enslavement.

In the afternoon, drive to Abomey historical city. on arrival, visit the 12 palaces of the Royal Palaces of Abomey, your visit will include a tour of the royal enclosure, museums, the King's tomb and Jewel Room.

Drive to Dassa Zoumé for the night

Day 5: Dassa Zoumé – Natitingou

Drive to Natitingou in the morning. On arrival, visit the museum where you will see what the region. Through the visit, you will return to the sources of the history of the region through life facts: religious practices, architecture, roles and place of men and women, their relationship with the region. earth and nature.

Night in Hôtel Tata Somba

Day 6: Natitingou – Tamberma Valley

Drive in the morning to Kousoukoingou and visit the unique Somba houses.

In the afternoon, cross the border in Boukoumbe to the Tamberma Valley and visit the Batamariba village in Togo side. The Batamariba tribe are famous with their unique mud tower-houses. It will be a step back in time because the Batamariba haven't changed their way of living. *BLD*

Overnight in Hotel la Douceur



Day 7: Tamberma Valley – Kpalimé

Drive to Kpalimé. It has a beautiful landscape and is located in the heart of the coffee and cocoa region.

Stop to see traditional weavers at work and also the Aledjo cave.

Overnight in Jess Hotel

Day 8: Kpalimé – Lomé

Embark on a hiking in ecotourism village in Kouma Konda. Walk through the houses, the forest to reach a small waterfall and admire the beautiful green and lush surroundings.

Visit of a waterfall



Visit of Havu village on the way to Lomé. Havu is a village where women and farmer are supported by a local tourist organisation.

Overnight in Hotel Napoléon

Day 9: Lomé – Agbodrafo

Stop in Aneho to see the Oasis, where the Lake Togo and the sea meet.

Drive to Agbodrafo and take a boat to cross Lake Togo to join Togoville village. You may enjoy one of the most unique and historical tour in Togo. Visit the Agbodrafo clandestine (slave trade in Agbodrafo was done clandestinely since the traders settled there after the first abolition). After learning about that part of the Togolese history and culture, enjoy a relaxing boat ride on Lake Togo to Togoville, the city from which the country got its name.

On arrival, walk around the village where there will be a display of voodoo statues; learn about the colonisation history by German and French.

Drive back to Lomé for the night.

Day 10: Lomé – UK

Lomé City Tour: Today, drive to Lomé, the capital city of Togo; once dubbed 'the pearl of West Africa'. It may be a shadow of its former self, but it retains a charm and nonchalance that is unique among West African capitals.

Visit will include the independence place, the national museum and Assigame Market and the center of Lomé,
